

ASKING 'WHERE?'

he:ʔey kaʔma ho:li:mu ?

'Where are you going?'

ʔa: ʔahčanhk^hay ho:li:na.

or

ʔahčanhk^hay ho:li:na

'I'm going home.'

NEW VOCABULARY

he:ʔey 'where?'

ho:li- 'to go; to leave' (motion away from speaker)

-:mu a suffix which generally means 'you are doing the verb'

ʔa: *or* ʔa:ʔa 'I'

ʔahča 'house'

-nhk^hay an ending combination which means '-ward' as in 'towards (something)'

-:na a suffix which generally means 'I am doing the verb'
